Mr. Sidwell was a member of St. Mary Catholic Church.

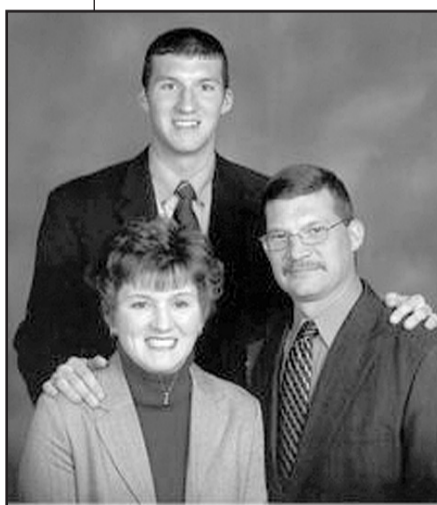
