1947- 2010 | Age 62

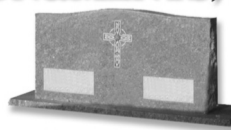
Junior K. Hatheway, 62, St. Joseph, went to be with the Lord, Wednesday, August 4, 2010.
